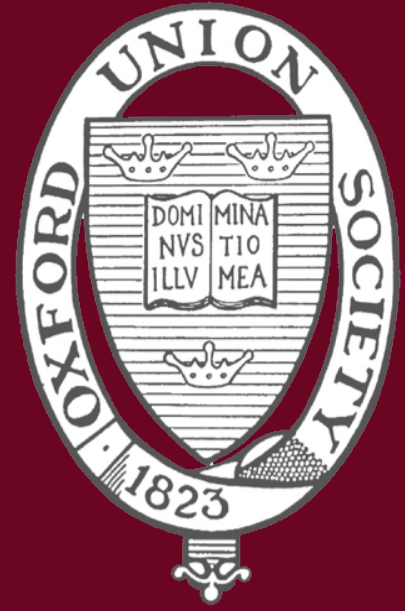

The Returning Officer and the Deputy Returning Officer work to ensure that Union Elections are free and fair. Any Electoral Malpractice should be reported to the Returning Officer either via the Union Office (Tel: 01865 241 353) or by emailing ro@oxford-union.org.

Electoral Malpractice includes (but is not limited to) the following:

Communicating untrue or misleading statements intending to influence the Election · Candidates representing themselves as endorsed by, supported by, or opposed by any political or national party, group or faction · Soliciting votes in the Society's buildings · Producing or distributing physical campaign materials or videos · Campaigning using any University email system · Spending money on advertising or publicising a Candidate or the Election · Engaging in organised treating · Using the Society's membership records to campaign · Impersonating others to hinder or promote any Candidate · Electoral pacts in different elections inside or outside the Society · Bribery or buying Memberships to influence the Election · Accessing another's electronic device, accounts or personal files without permission · Misusing an official position within the Society or elsewhere in order to campaign · Procure any vehicle to systematically transport Members to the Poll · Loitering in or outside the Poll Room · Impersonate any other person when voting · Breaching the secrecy of the Count · Physically reproducing or defacing any electronic or physical Electoral material produced by the Returning Officer · Hindering any Electoral Official · Making vexatious Allegations · Act in any violent manner that is liable to distress, grossly offend, or intimidate others in connection with the election · Harassment, bullying, or victimisation · Discrimination · Extortion or blackmail

ELECTORAL MALPRACTICE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED - Rule 33 exists for a reason.
