

The Oxford Union Guest Policy

Non-ticketed events

Members are able to bring up to three guests provided that:

1. The guest is not themselves eligible for membership of the Oxford Union.
2. For debates and events so marked at the President's discretion, in consultation with the Standing Committee, the guest pays a £25 fee on the door.
3. For all other non-ticketed events, the guests pays a £12.50 fee on the door.
4. The guest has not already visited three times that term.
5. The member accompanies their guest at all times, and takes full responsibility for them.

Events may be made exclusive to members when there is a security risk.

Ticketed events

Members are able to bring up to three guests provided that:

1. The guest is not themselves eligible for membership of the Oxford Union.
2. For events ticketed for Members, the guest pays a fee higher than members.
3. The member accompanies their guest at all times, and takes full responsibility for them.

Member's Bar

Members are able to bring guests to the Members' Bar without incurring a guest charge, but must sign them in in the Guest Book at the Bar.

Snooker Room

Members are able to admit up to three guests into the snooker room provided that:

1. The guest is not themselves eligible for membership of the Oxford Union.
2. The Member pays a fee of £4.17 per Guest
